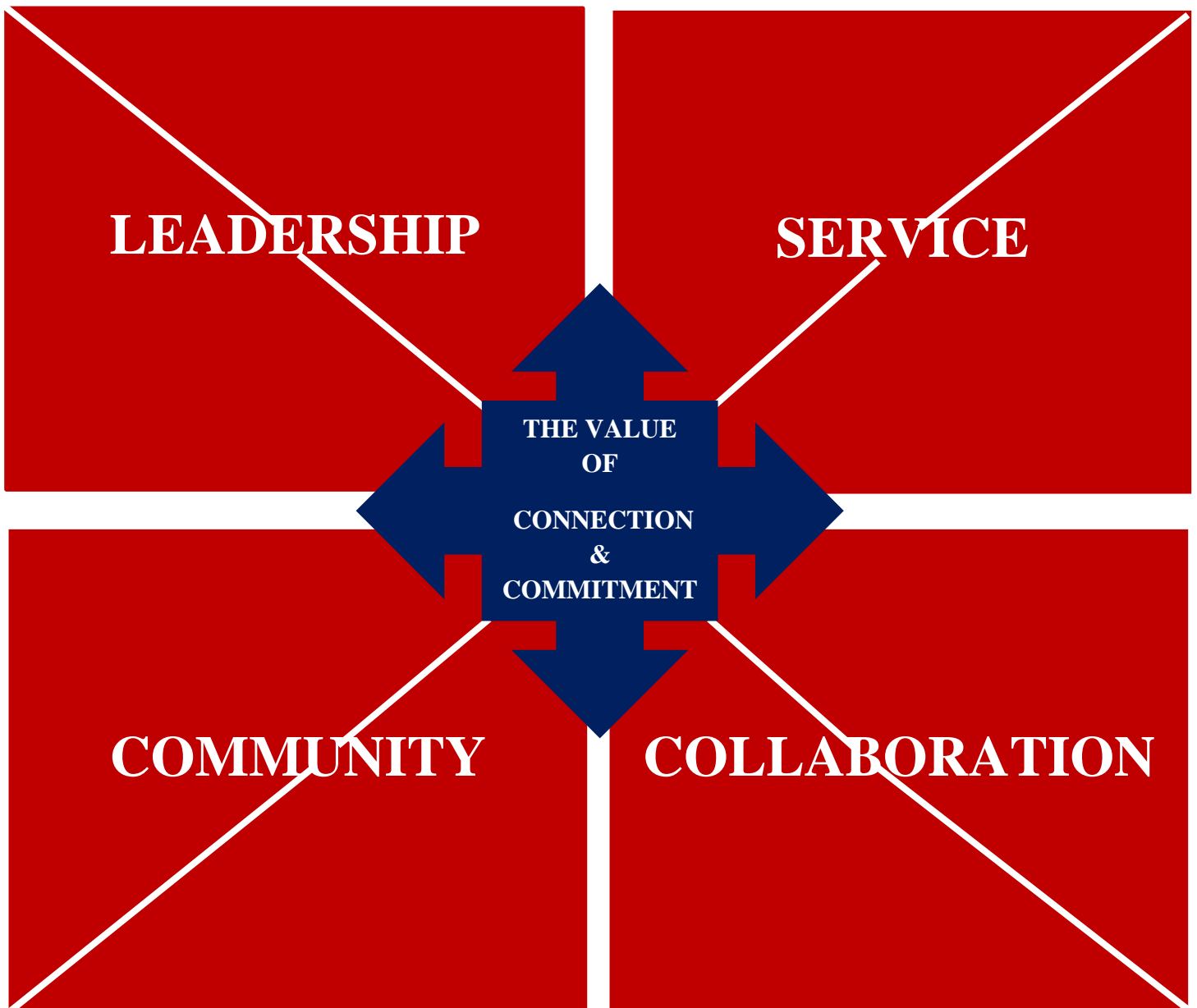

# East Lubbock Leadership Institute Overview

## Purpose

Members of the East Lubbock Community Alliance (ELCA) began discussing the needs of the community, which were conveyed through the community forums and various other community outreach efforts. Although many plans and visions for north and east Lubbock exist, the ELCA Strategic Planning Committee believed the core of ‘what’s missing’ remained elusive. During a Strategic Planning Committee brainstorming session, after discussing the wants and needs conveyed by those who reside in the community, the Committee realized the core of what the community needs, and desires is leadership training, which will allow community members to blaze their own paths to success. Regardless of the path, be it education, community development, health & wellness, youth initiatives, or faith-based efforts, we realized the community desires to have the skills to be leaders of their own destiny. As a result, the Committee recalibrated its thinking and began to focus on creating a leadership institute, which will harness the gifts and talents thus producing leaders from within. These leaders will be groomed and cultivated to take charge of the leadership institute, train future leaders, and transition into serving in key roles and responsibilities to become the change each community member wants to see!

## Goals

The goals of the East Lubbock Leadership Institute are as follows:

1. Create community leaders from within;
2. Create well-informed individuals who can serve as a body to inform decision-makers on the needs and desires of east Lubbock;
3. Create community infrastructure (a group of people) to ensure the sustainability of all social and physical investments in east Lubbock; and
4. Establish a succession plan, which will mentor and groom future East Lubbock leaders!

## Outcomes

The following outcomes will help achieve the above-mentioned leadership institute goals:

1. Endorsement from the City of Lubbock, LISD, and other governmental, non or quasi-governmental decision-making bodies to formally recognize and support graduate leaders from the institute; and
2. Place leadership graduates on key boards, commissions civic groups, or other decision-making groups to help ensure the well-being of the community is nurtured by members from the community.
