Description of Quarterly Performance or Outcome:

In October 2016, the Executive Director received a scholarship from HUD to attend a Neighbor Works Training Institute in Washington, DC; the scholarship paid for the tuition and hotel expenses. NELCDC paid \$580.74 for the flight, disbursed \$379.50 for per diem, and \$300 for the hotel deposit. The deposit was returned to the NELCDC and unspent per diem in the amount of \$122.33 was deposited back into the city grant fund account. Training was held Dec. 12-16, 2016. Ms. Coleman received an NCHEC Certification in Homeownership Counseling for Program Mangers and Executive Directors.

In December 2016, NELCDC planned for three staff (3) members to attend a place-based NeighborWorks Training Institute in Austin, TX in February 2017. All three (3) NELCDC employees submitted a training scholarship application to the Texas State Affordable Housing Corp.; one was received, which covered the \$909.50 room expense. Two employees shared a room; one employee had his own room - \$909.50. The registration fee was \$100 per person. If the class would have been taken at a national training institute, the cost would have been \$1,455 per person. The place-based training and scholarship was a great financial benefit to the NELCDC. Flights were purchased in January 2017. Per diem was issued in the month of February 2017. All three staff members received a NCHEC Certification in Pre-Purchase Homeownership Education. This class, held Feb. 6-10, 2017, was critical to the service delivery of the NELCDC's monthly homebuyer education and financial literacy workshop.

Lewis Vega, NELCDC Program Manager also received a scholarship to attend a NeighborWorks Training Institution in Seattle, Washington. NELCDC reimbursed Mr. Vega for his flight in the amount of \$363.70. All hotel expenses and class tuition was paid for via a scholarship from HUD; the class tuition for the Homeownership Counseling Certification, which is a requirement for the Program Manager position is \$1,600. Per diem was issued in February 2017.

Description of Quarterly Performance or Outcome:

NELCDC facilitated the financial literacy and homebuyer education workshop to 25 households as follows:

- 10 in October 2016
- 4 in November 2016
- 11 in December 2016

The goal is to market the financial literacy workshops to prospective first-time homebuyers. Upon completion of the course, if clients decide to take the next step, they complete the intake process to become a one-on-one client. The counseling process is completed once clients met mortgage-readiness thresholds, including but not limited to money saved; determination of income eligibility for down-payment and closing cost assistance, credit thresholds, no collections or unresolved charge-offs, no recent bankruptcy (within the last 2 years). A list of referral partners is provided if requested. With all obstacles to homeownership being removed, the clients are ready to pursue homeownership. *Budget comments above apply for this third type of service delivery*.
